Color Outside the Lines

Not only did interior designer [Uma Stewart](#) design this beautiful dining nook, but she also designed [the unique pillow fabric](#) that so perfectly completes the space. "As a textile designer, working with prints rather than wovens, I was looking for a way to convey a plaid-like pattern in a print," Uma says of the textile design process. "The large squares gave the look, but because we weren't working with woven techniques, we could add the third color in the pattern. We gave the blocks in the check a watercolor look on close inspection, as the lines are intentionally not perfectly straight. And there is some color overlap, as well."

Even Uma's modern version of buffalo check achieves the versatility that the basic pattern is known for. "Buffalo check conveys casual, classic and current. We chose [the pattern] for the space because it brings in those qualities," she says.
